

Official Terms and Conditions

By participating in the **You Can Have It All – Open Verse Challenge** (the “Challenge”), you agree to be bound by these Official Terms and Conditions (the “Rules”). By submitting an entry, participants acknowledge that they have read and agree to these Official Rules & Terms.

1. Overview

You Can Have It All – Open Verse Challenge (the “Challenge”) is an online songwriting contest taking place during JUNO Week 2026. Participants are invited to write and record an original open verse to the official Challenge song and share it publicly on social media.

This Challenge is JUNO Week-adjacent but is not sponsored, endorsed, administered by, or associated with the JUNO Awards, CARAS, Instagram, YouTube, TikTok, Meta, Google, or any of their affiliates.

The Challenge is organized by **One New Era X**, operating in Ontario, Canada (the “Organizer”).

Sponsor Disclaimer:

This Challenge may be supported by third-party sponsors, including alcohol brands. Sponsor participation is limited to brand acknowledgment only. Alcohol is not a prize, is not being promoted or endorsed in connection with this Challenge, and no purchase is required to participate. This Challenge is open to participants **nineteen (19) years of age or older**.

2. Eligibility

The Challenge is open to legal residents of Canada, **excluding the Province of Quebec**, who are **nineteen (19) years of age or older** at the time of entry. Residents of Quebec are not eligible to participate.

Participants must have a valid, public Instagram, TikTok, and/or YouTube account in good standing.

By entering the Challenge, participants confirm that they meet the age requirement and agree to be bound by these Official Rules. Proof of age and eligibility may be required prior to the awarding of any prize.

Void where prohibited by law.

3. How to Enter

- a) Write and record an original verse using the official “**You Can Have It All**” open-verse template. Your verse must be original and created specifically for this Challenge.
- b) Post your recording on a **public** Instagram, TikTok, or YouTube account.
- c) Tag **@anthonydidomenico** and **@bexgalaxy** and include the hashtag **#YouCanHaveItAllContest** in the post caption.
- d) Upon submitting a valid entry, each participant may nominate **one (1)** friend to join the Challenge by tagging them in the original post caption. To be eligible for the nomination prize, the nomination must:
- Be publicly visible at the time of submission and remain publicly visible through the winner selection date;
 - Include the hashtag **#YouCanHaveItAllContest** within the original caption; and
 - Clearly tag only one individual. If more than one individual is tagged in the caption, the **first tagged name appearing in the original caption at the time of posting** will be deemed the official nomination. Subsequent edits, reordering of tags, or additional tags added after the original post time will not be considered.

Participants are required to take a screenshot of their entry at the time of posting, clearly showing the full caption and visible timestamp. This screenshot may be requested by the contest organizers as proof of entry.

e) If a nominated artist wins the Grand Prize, **one (1) nominator** will receive a **\$500 CAD cash prize**. The prize will be awarded to the first eligible nomination associated with the winning artist, based on timestamp. In the event of unclear timing or disputes, the Organizer reserves the right to determine the recipient at its sole discretion.

Entries that are edited, altered, or added after the official deadline – including caption revisions – may be disqualified at the sole discretion of the organizers. Failure to provide timestamped proof upon request may result in removal from eligibility.

Entries must be submitted between **February 15, 2026 at 11:00 AM (ET)** and **March 15, 2026 at 11:59 PM (ET)**. Late, incomplete, private, improperly tagged, or non-compliant entries may be disqualified at the sole discretion of the Organizer.

4. Skill-Testing Question

To be declared a winner and receive a prize, selected participants must correctly answer a time-limited mathematical skill-testing question without assistance, as required under Canadian law.

5. Prizes

Grand Prize: One (1) prize of \$2,000 CAD

Nominee Bonus: One (1) prize of \$500 CAD, awarded in connection with the nomination process

The Nominee Bonus may be awarded at the sole discretion of the Organizer, including but not limited to:

- The first verified nominator of the winning participant, or
- Another allocation method determined by the Organizer for fairness and feasibility

All prizes may be delivered via prepaid debit card or equivalent method. Prizes are non-transferable and have no cash substitution except at the Organizer's discretion.

All prizes will be awarded only to verified eligible winners who meet the age and eligibility requirements at the time of entry.

Alcohol is not included as part of any prize.

6. Winner Selection

Winners are selected using a blended scoring system:

- **Community Engagement (40%)** – based on likes, shares, and overall engagement on the entry post
- **Judges' Score (60%)** – evaluated based on creativity, originality, delivery, and alignment with the spirit of the song

Community engagement may increase visibility; however, judges make the final determination. Judges' decisions are final and binding.

Odds of winning depend on the number of eligible entries received.

7. Rights & Ownership

The original Challenge song, including its underlying composition and master recording (excluding participant contributions), remains the sole property of the Organizer.

Participants retain ownership of the original lyrics and melody they contribute to the open verse. By entering, participants grant the Organizer a non-exclusive, royalty-free, worldwide, perpetual license to use, reproduce, repost, distribute, and publicly display submitted content for promotional, marketing, documentation, and research-related purposes connected to the Challenge and future related initiatives.

Participants represent and warrant that their submission is original and does not infringe upon the rights of any third party.

8. Community Guidelines

This Challenge celebrates creativity, empowerment, and mental well-being. Submissions containing hate speech, harassment, or harmful content may be removed at the Organizer's discretion.

Fully AI-generated lyrics or performances are not permitted. The use of AI tools for inspiration or assistance is acceptable, provided the final submission is meaningfully created and performed by the participant. The Organizer reserves the right to disqualify entries that do not align with the spirit of original artistic contribution.

9. Winner Notification and Verification

Winners will be announced on **March 29, 2026** via Instagram and TikTok and contacted through direct message.

Potential winners may be required to:

- a) Provide proof of eligibility
- b) Complete an affidavit of eligibility

Failure to comply may result in disqualification and selection of an alternate winner.

10. Release & Limitation of Liability

By participating, participants agree to release and hold harmless the Organizer from any claims arising from participation in the Challenge, including but not limited to technical failures, platform issues, lost or delayed entries, or disputes between participants.

Participants acknowledge that Instagram, TikTok, YouTube, Meta, and Google are in no way responsible for the administration of this Challenge and are fully released from any liability related to participation.

11. Modifications & Cancellation

The Organizer reserves the right to modify, suspend, or cancel the Challenge if circumstances require, including but not limited to technical issues, fraud, or force majeure events.

12. Governing Law

These Rules are governed by the laws of the Province of Ontario and the laws of Canada applicable therein, without regard to conflict of law principles.

13. Privacy

Personal information collected will be used solely for administering the Challenge and will not be sold or shared with third parties, except as required by law.
